

This publication replaces Report No. INS. It is essential to destroy all previous lists of evaluations and to use only the present publication as an aid in the evaluation of qualifications which appear therein.

It should be noted that where Standard Ten is mentioned in this publication it refers to the final school examination which is written on completion of the secondary school course. An evaluation of Standard Ten or higher does not imply exemption from the requirements of the Joint Matriculation Board for Matriculation exemption. When this is required, the Secretary of the Joint Matriculation Board, P.O. Box 3854, Pretoria, should be approached.

It should be noted that for teachers' salary purposes education departments in the Republic of South Africa carry out their own evaluation of qualifications. Persons wishing to be admitted to the teaching profession should submit their certificates and diplomas for evaluation to the education department concerned.

Evaluations as indicated bear no reference to exemption from any examination.

EVALUATION OF QUALIFICATIONS

GENERAL

Criteria for evaluation

The following general criteria are taken into account:

- 1. Qualifications required for admission to the course of study.
- 2. The status of the institution issuing the certificate e.g. university, technical college, trade school.
- 3. Duration of the course (full-time or part-time).
- 4. Contents of the course and examination requirements (e.g. curriculum of the course, standard of subjects included).
- 5. Research or thesis required for degree or diploma.
- 6. Recognition accorded to the qualification in the country of origin.

Evaluation of qualifications issued by professional institutes

The following are the accepted principles under this heading:

- 1. Every criterion usually considered in the evaluation of diplomas and certificates, cannot always be applied to every diploma and certificate. Consequently only those criteria which are applicable are taken into account; the important factor, however, remains the actual standard which is attained.
- 2. Recognition is accorded only to certificates/diplomas which are issued on the successful completion of an examination.
- 3. Membership obtained through experience, payment of fees, honorary membership, etc. and which is not acquired by virtue of an examination, is not regarded as an academic qualification and no additional recognition may be awarded to it.

Evaluation of South African university qualifications

General Principles

- 1. The actual number of years of full—time study at a university as well as the contents of the syllabus serve as the basis for the assessment of these certificates.
- 2. Degrees:
 - (a) Bachelor's degree

The recognition which a Bachelor's degree receives, will be equal to the minimum number of years after matriculation in which the specific degree can be attained at any South African university.

(b) The Honours degree or the examination part of the Master's degree

An Honours degree will receive recognition if it follows a first Bachelor's degree. (See Par. 2(a)). One additional year's recognition is accorded.

(c) Master's degree

The evaluation of a Master's degree is as follows:

- (i) After a recognised three—year Bachelor¹s degree, 2 years additional.
- (ii) After a recognised Honours degree, 1 year additional.

However, no Master's degree will be evaluated higher than Std. 10 + 6 years.

(d) Doctor's degree

Master's degree plus 2 years.

3. Diplomas:

(a) Post-standard 10 diplomas

The same principle applies as in the case of the Bachelor's degree, provided that no diploma will receive higher recognition than the corresponding Bachelor's degree.

(b) Post—graduate diplomas

If the diploma requires one or more years post-graduate study, recognition for one additional year is granted.

4. More than one degree or diploma on the same level:

Recognition for one additional year will be granted to a second degree or diploma on the same level as a previous degree or diploma provided that the second degree or diploma included at least 50% new courses.

- 5. Medical and dental degrees and diplomas are not included in the above.
- 6. Uncompleted courses:

Recognition will be granted to uncompleted university degrees/diplomas, if the candidate has completed the total number of courses for the specific year according to university regulations, provided however, that recognition thus obtained is at least one year less than the minimum number of years in which the degree/diploma can be attained in South Africa.

Evaluation of qualifications of foreign universities

- 1. The general principles for the evaluation of qualifications of South African universities apply.
- 2. Doctor's degrees of certain foreign countries are therefore equated to South African Master's degrees.
- 3. Should a holder of a Doctor's degree which has been equated to a South African Master's degree, so desire, consideration may be given for the submission of his thesis to two independent South African specialists in the particular field of study. If these specialists agree that the thesis is of the same standard of work and study as that required for a Doctor's degree at a South African university, the foreign Doctor's degree will be equated to a South African Doctor's degree.

The value of certificates and diplomas of private institutions

The statements and/or certificates regarding Standards Six, Seven, Eight and Nine, as issued by registered private schools, will be evaluated according to the requirements of the province in which the School is situated.
