AI Fraud Detection

- Whistle Blowers not successful in South Africa
- External Audits are not thorough
- Need Internal AI Fraud Detection
- Need data to model a thorough AI Audit
- Boost trusts in the economy



AI Solves Bloom's 2 Sigma Problem

- Bloom (1984) finds best Teaching Model requires 1 to 1 teaching model. Direct access to subject expert.
- Results are 2 levels (sigmas) better than the traditional model
- Too expensive – not practical
- Now possible with AI
- Imagine South African students accessing expert knowledge on all subjects
- Need to invest in AI in Education now

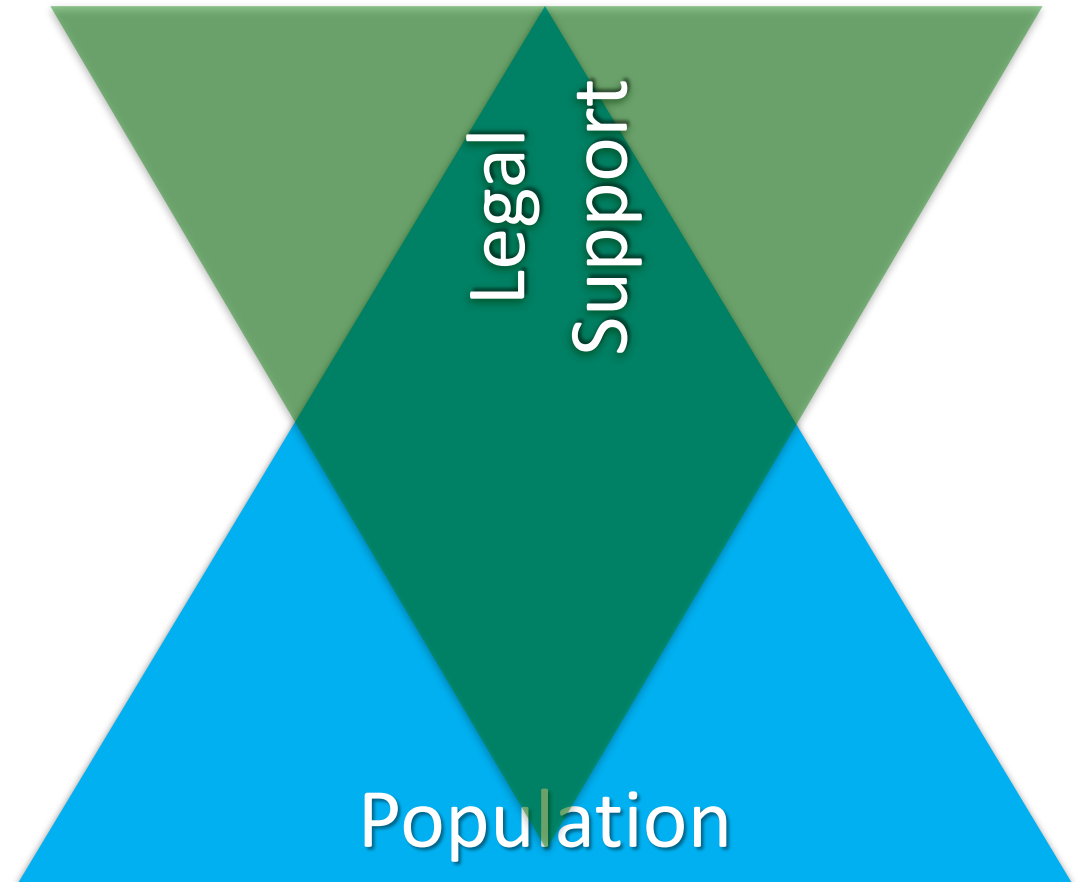

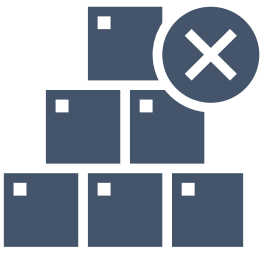

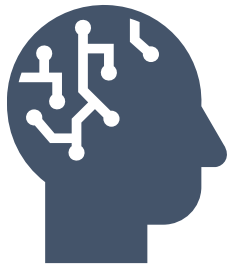

Duplicated and conflicting mandates

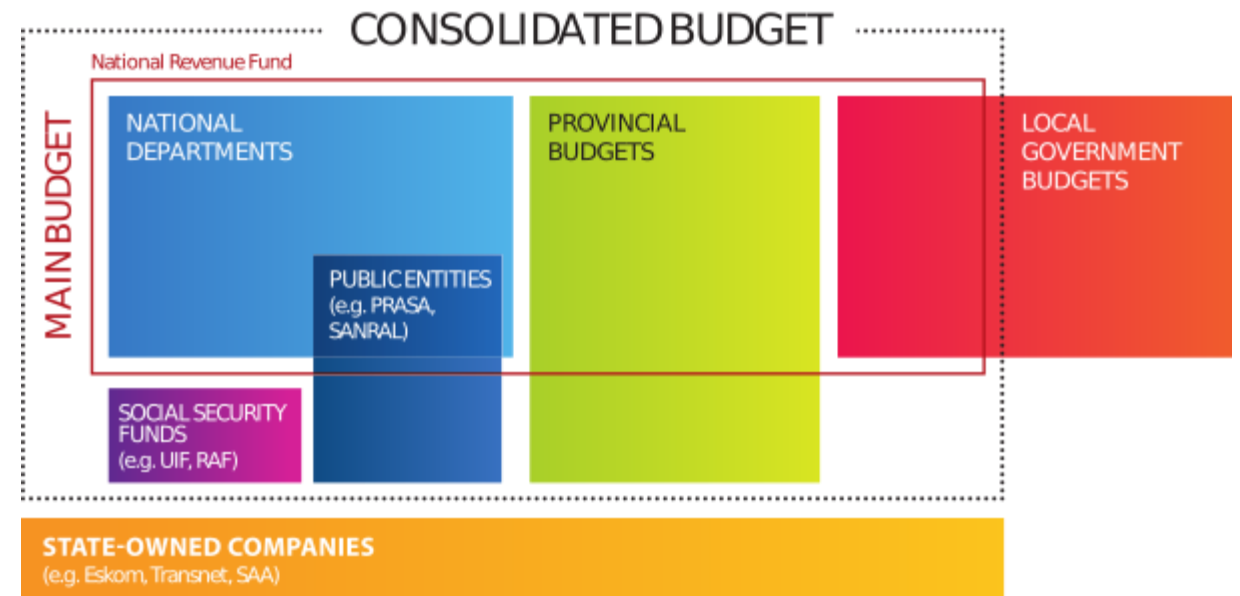


Difficult to have single understanding of what each agency/department is doing
