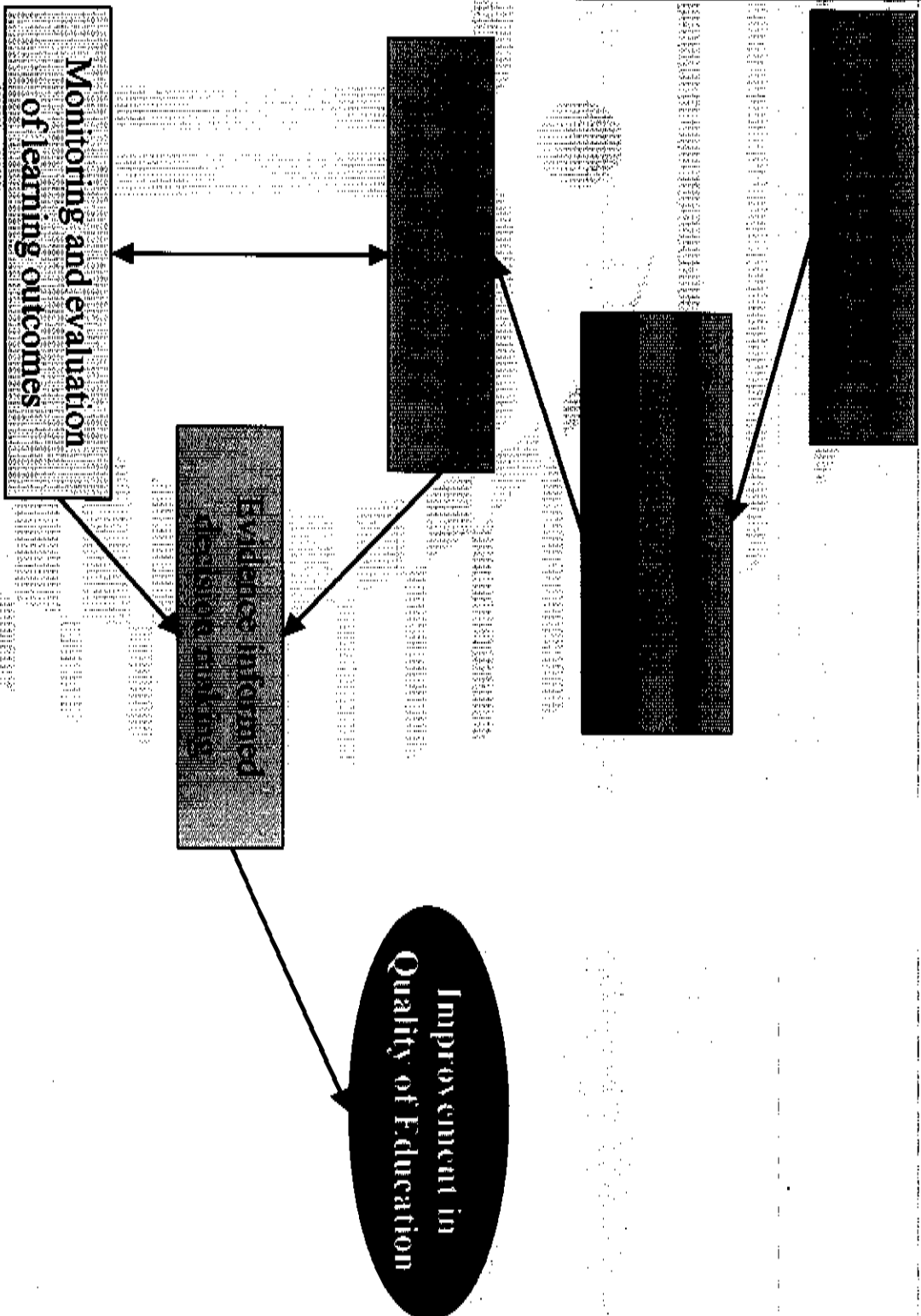

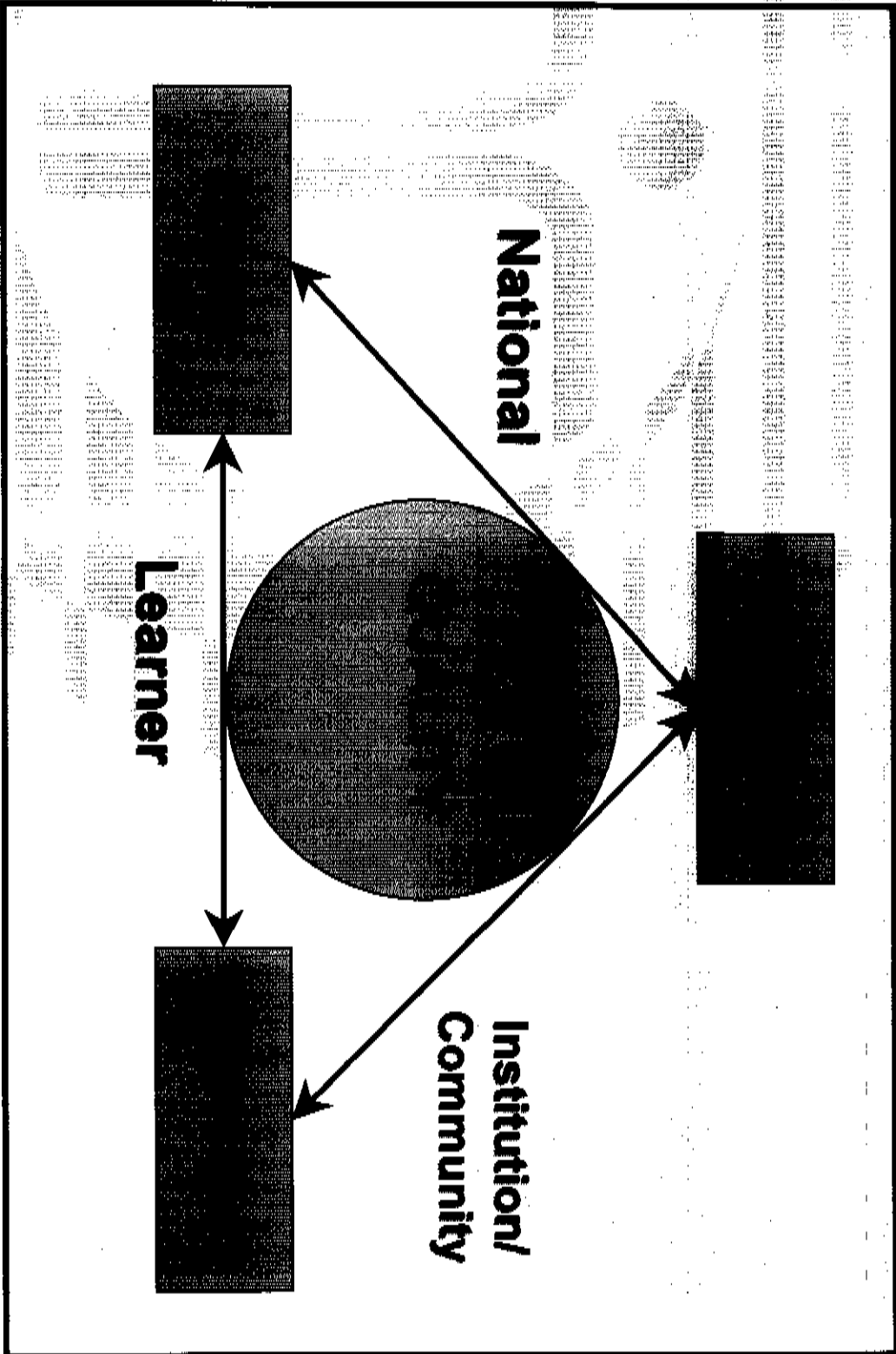
Research Questions

- **To understand the conditions for success for improving the quality of education in Sub Saharan Africa and South Asia.**
 - What are the underlying logic and assumptions of the nature of quality and thus quality improvement initiatives across the study countries?
 - What political, social and economic conditions facilitate or impede the improvement of educational quality?
 - What factors relating to gender, ethnicity and HIV/AIDS mediate the attainment of quality of education?
- **To develop measures of quality improvement for policy makers at the system and school levels**
 - What indicators are required to capture and measure quality over time?
 - How to monitor and track dynamics of change in quality that impacts on the system, school/communities and learning outcomes?
 - How to design evidence based action strategies for improving quality, especially in remote and difficult delivery contexts?

Research Questions

- To apply and evaluate the effectiveness of a systems model for improving the quality of education through improved and evidence informed decision making
 - What local context specific information is needed for the effective implementation/adaptation of the AQEE model to enhance evidence informed decision making?
 - What are the systems, tools and capacity necessary to support the implementation of the AQEE model in the various contexts?
 - Has the application of the AQEE model enhanced decision making and has this led to an improvement in education quality?
- To understand and promote changes in governance systems at the local level particularly in overcrowded, remote and other difficult delivery contexts
 - How does community participation contribute to improving educational quality?
 - How does the nature of school management and classroom practices contribute to the improvement of educational quality?
 - How does the nature of classroom processes contribute to the improvement of educational quality?

Research Questions

- To develop context linked designs for measuring and monitoring change in learning outcomes
 - How to enhance learning outcomes in schools in difficulty delivery contexts, e.g. remote, multigrade, minority dominated schools?
 - What factors would facilitate or impede sustainable improvement in learning outcomes in varying contexts?
- To identify processes for improving South-South collaboration and dissemination and utilisation of information for improving education quality
 - What kind of networks best enhance regional cooperation?
 - How should information be disseminated to ensure greater utilisation in systems characterised by difficult delivery contexts?
 - What are the obstacles and challenges for establishing and maintaining a Southern African – South Asian education quality network?
